

Activity Report of Asociația Conservatorilor și Rstauratorilor din România (A.C.R.R.O.) for 2014

A.C.R.R.O.'s strategy for the year 2014 was centered on continuity, as the steering committee stayed the same. Transparency of the activities was assured through information uploaded on the association's webpage.

The association was represented at the ECCO General Assembly in Bolzano by acting president Olimpia Mureșan. At this time, a short presentation of A.C.R.R.O.'s activities during 2013 was made. The association's intention of becoming a full member of ECCO was reiterated. For this to happen, A.C.R.R.O.'s members status has to be clarified.

With the support of our colleagues in Slovenia, the association managed to take part at the poster session from 06.05.2015 in Liubliana. The participants were: Ghinea Balmuș Cătălin (member since the begin of 2014), Ilie Aurora, Mureșan Olimpia, Sidoriuc Eugenia, Știrban Alexandru.

The events of 2014: A.C.R.R.O. Days, the poster session and the General Assembly took place in october, at the Pelișor castle in Sinaia, situated close to the Peleș castle. It was the third poster session organised by A.C.R.R.O. and the second under the name of „Retrospectives” .

The opening of the exhibition took place in front of the Peleș Museum's management, of the manager of the Culture Department of Prahova county, of the association's members and of the conservators and restorers of the hosting museum.

Four *Meritoria* certificates were awarded during the opening festivities.

At the General Assembly of the association, the steering committee's mandate was extended.
