Achievements	<p>MP Raphaël Gérard deposited in January 2022 a project for a law proposal regarding the creation of a protected title for conservator-restorers. It was not examined by the Parliament, due to the fact that Presidential elections in April/May 2022 modified the composition of both the National Assembly and the Senate. Still, it showed a political interest for our profession.</p> <p>Two meetings of a specific working group on that topic took place at the Ministry of Culture during the year.</p>
